First Visit and Application Process

- 1) Membership of Westfield ARC runs from 1st February to 31st January annually.
- 2) All full members of Westfield ARC must hold a valid AWL.
- 3) Any new visitor considering joining Westfield ARC, must submit a completed membership application form on their first visit. This will have the date of the first visit written on it by a committee member. Westfield ARC operates a maximum 3 visit rule. At each visit a visitor pass will be issued and must be worn at all times when on the grounds.
- 4) A photograph will be taken to be used for membership records and membership card. By signing this form, you consent to this.
- 5) All applications will be accepted or rejected by the membership secretary or at a committee meeting.
- 6) If anyone knows of any good reason to believe an application is unacceptable, they should inform the membership secretary accordingly and the Committee will then decide whether or not the application is acceptable.
- 7) If the application reveals anything detrimental then the application will be rejected and the applicant will be informed as soon as possible that they cannot be accepted as a member or visitor at Westfield ARC.
- 8) If the application is accepted, then a probationary membership period will commence. This will be six (6) months from the date of first visit. Probationary members must attend the club at least 6 times within this period and demonstrate safe practice
- 9) The relevant joining fee and subscription become due as soon as the applicant receives notification that they have been accepted as a probationary member. Once relevant fees have been paid, a membership card will be issued together with a lanyard pass holder. Membership cards should be worn at all times when on the grounds.
- 10) In exceptional circumstances (e.g. past members or known applicant moving from another club) full membership may be granted immediately at the discretion of the committee.
- 11) Probationary members are not allowed on the grounds unless there is a full member present. Security lock combinations will not be issued to probationary members.
- 12) At the end of the probationary period (or sooner if circumstances dictate) the probationary member will be advised if they are **not** being accepted as a full member. If the applicant does not receive such notification, full membership status will automatically apply and the member may then request the security lock combinations. Only committee members have security access to some areas
- 13) In the event a probationary member is refused full membership; the following will be refunded. If they have paid the full annual membership fee at the time their probationary membership is ended - a refund of 1/2 the annual fee (irrespective of when the probationary membership is ended). If they have paid a half years membership fee - no refund (irrespective of when the probationary membership is ended) - the joining fee is not refundable in whole or part.
- 14) Only sub 12 ftlb air rifles and sub 6 ftlb pistols may be brought on to club grounds. All guns brought on to grounds for the first time, must be chrono'ed. Any guns on club grounds may be chrono'ed at any time. Any gun over power stated, per the club chronograph, must be removed from club grounds immediately and not returned until it is under powers stated above. Such guns will be re-tested before use on club grounds. A record of results is kept
- 15) All new members must attend an induction session. A record of this must be signed and will be kept on file by Westfield ARC.
- 16) All members must sign in using the register provided upon every visit to the grounds, even if not shooting.
- 17) We recommend you purchase Personal Public Liability Insurance to cover shooting. Available from STS, SACS, NSRA, BASC etc.

I agree to the above terms and also agree to comply with the club's safety rules, Constitution and instructions from any Range Control officer, committee member or appointed Club Officer.
